## **Target Golf & Mini Golf**

Target Golf and Mini Golf are excellent outdoor activities for students to develop knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to lead an active, healthy lifestyle through the sport of golf.

#### What is...

**Target Golf:** students hit golf balls uphill, aiming at yardages and novelty targets. Like a driving range.

**Mini Golf:** 18 holes of the classic putting fun you already know and love.

# Target Golf What is included:

- Up to an hour of access to 10 tee boxes
- Unlimited golf balls
- FREE golf clubs (7, 8 and 9 irons. LH & RH .)

**Booking Info:** Up to 30 kids per hour (3/tee box).

#### Mini Golf What is included:

 Unlimited access for your students to our outdoor mini golf course.

Balls, putters, and scorecards.

**Booking Info:** Up to 30 students per hour *(or 50 kids per 1.5 hours)* 

#### What to bring

Dress appropriately for the weather (hat, sunscreen, etc.) and for the level of physical activity.

## Whitemud Creek Mining Co.

This is a recreational sluice that allows kids to discover rocks, gemstones, fossils, and minerals.

How it works: each student recieves a bag of rough filled with either rocks & minerals or fossils (that they get to keep). They rinse the rough through a panning screen to find the items. A key to each item is included to help identify the item and where it is from.

This activity is not long and may be added to other activities or be repeated. Smiles and geological treasures guaranteed!
