Snow Valley's **COMMUNITY INITIATIVE PROGRAM** provides a fun, friendly, and safe environment with qualified instructors teaching beginner skills in skiing and snowboarding to youth and new Canadians to get out there and make winter fun.

**Step 1** - Complete the **Organization Application** form and e-mail or fax to the Snow Valley School and Groups Program Coordinator. Identify what kind of excursion you are looking for, how many individuals, and the date and time that you prefer. (See following page for the options)

**Step 2** - The School and Groups Program Coordinator will contact you to discuss the request.

**Step 3** - Once the type of excursion, date and time have been set a confirmation package will be sent to the organizer.

**Step 4** - On receiving the excursion confirmation package, you will find fitting sheets to be completed by all the individuals taking part in the trip. The fitting sheets must be returned **seven (7) days before** the excursion.

**Step 5** - Upon arrival to the hill your group will be met by a Snow Valley representative who will give you your area passes and preprinted rental waivers. Each waiver needs to be signed.

**Step 6** - All participants will proceed to the Rental Shop for their helmets and equipment.

**Step 7** - Participants are asked to be at the blue "Meeting place" flag at least 5 minutes before the scheduled lesson time. The lessons begin at the scheduled time, so do not be late.

**Step 8** - After the lesson, participants will have free time to keep practicing their newly learned skills until your group's scheduled departure time.

## 2015 - 2016 LESSON OPTIONS

### **1. DISCOVER LESSON PACKAGE: 2 one hour beginner group lessons in 1 day**

We have the opportunity for you to take part in the Introductory Discover Ski or Discover Snowboarding classes. The first 1 hour lesson will be at 10:45 for Skiing and 9:30 for Snowboarding then you will have a break so you can have lunch and practice what you have learned. The second lesson will be at 1:45 for Skiing and 12:30 for Snowboarding. There is a minimum of 6 participants and a maximum of 12 for each skiing or snowboarding lesson.
