

WHAT TO EXPECT

Upon Arrival at Snow Valley

1. Proceed to Guest Services to purchase your area pass, rental equipment and/or lessons.
2. If you have purchased rental equipment, Guest Services will then direct you to the Rental Equipment area, where you will receive your rental equipment, ie. skis, snowboards, boots and/or helmets. Once you have your equipment and your boots are on, you are ready to head outside.
4. If you have a lesson booked, your ski or snowboard instructor(s) will meet you out on the snow!

Snow Valley staff are available to assist with various aspects of your visit. This includes ensuring that you receive appropriate rental equipment, proper area passes, and ski or snowboard lessons. It is important that everyone listens carefully to the information Snow Valley staff provide and follows their directions.

Area Passes

All skiers/riders require an area pass prior to getting onto any of our lifts. An area pass allows access to Snow Valley runs, however there is a responsibility that comes with it. By wearing an area pass the skier/rider is agreeing to the restrictions of Snow Valley and takes on the responsibility of respecting the rights of all other skiers and riders. An area pass will be issued for the day you are skiing/riding. This date will be printed on the front of the pass. On the reverse of the pass is the Exclusion of Liability. Snow Valley requests everyone accepting an area pass with the intent to use it, read this information.

The Exclusion of Liability conditions are also found on a sign at Guest Services and at the Ticket Window at Snow Valley. Everyone who purchases an area pass should be aware of these conditions and realize that they are accepting responsibility for their own safety.

Here's an example of our Exclusion of Liability Sign and the Area Pass itself. Please read the terms carefully and make sure you understand the responsibility that comes with purchasing and wearing the area pass.

Ticket Window Sign – Exclusion of Liability

This sign is posted at Guest Services and the Ticket Window and is to be read prior to purchasing an area pass.
