

## Mite Ski 4 – 5 yrs old

### A – From the beginning

(Start) These students have typically never skied before, or they have only been out with their parents once or twice, often over a year ago.

(End) Stopping without an Edgie Wedgie.

### B – Learning to Turn

(Start) The students may need a quick refresher on stopping, but are ready to learn to turn.

(End) Inconsistent and unconfident turning down Old Road (Green Terrain)

### C – Turning on Green Terrain

(Start) These students are able to confidently turn on Discover (beginner terrain), and may have been up the chair once to twice. They are not yet ready for Cascade (blue terrain).

(End) Comfortable down saddle of Cascade (Moderate Blue Terrain)

### D – Turning on Blue Terrain

(Start) These students are comfortable skiing on the saddle of Cascade (moderate blue terrain).

(End) Ski Anywhere at Snow Valley comfortably.

### E – Starting to Ski Parallel

(Start) These students are able to ski on all runs at Snow Valley.

(End) Parallel at Snow Valley
